In December of 2022, President Biden signed a bipartisan law called the NDAA “National Defense Authorization Act”, which included Section 889 relating to security and communications equipment. Its goal is to lessen and eventually eliminate components from manufacturers that are deemed to pose threats to National defense. Based primarily around manufacturers who do business either indirectly or directly with government entities designated as “critical systems”, its impact has expanded into any industry associated with infrastructure.
